## IN CASE OF ACCIDENT

24 Hr Emergency Phone Number: 111 or 0800 CHEMCALL – 0800 243 6225

<b>Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills or leaks. <b>Call emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or Leak</b>	Use appropriate protective equipment. Spills may be slippery and should be cleaned up immediately. Dike and pump as much as possible into a salvage container. Absorb the remaining liquid and any small spills with clay granules, sand, or other absorbant material and sweep into a waste container. Minimise run-off into drains or waterways.
<b>Fire</b>	Vapours may be toxic. Self-contained breathing apparatus required, chemical suit recommended. Addition of water may cause excessive foaming. Do not allow contaminated run-off to enter drains or waterways.
<b>First Aid</b>	Remove victim to fresh air. Apply resuscitation if victim is not breathing. <b>Do not use direct mouth-to-mouth method if victim has ingested or inhaled the product</b> , use alternative method or respiratory device. Administer Oxygen if breathing is difficult. <b>Ingestion:</b> If swallowed, rinse mouth with water, DO NOT induce vomiting. Seek medical advice. <b>Eyes:</b> Immediately flush eyes with flowing water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. <b>Skin:</b> Immediately flush with plenty of water while removing contaminated clothing. DO NOT scrub the skin. Continue for at least 15 minutes.
